HOW IT WORKS

Thermoskin is sprayed onto freshly shorn sheep using a portable spray unit positioned at the end of the race. The unit creates a fine mist that covers each sheep in seconds, including the tips of the wool and bare skin (stomach, flanks, etc.)



Takes a few seconds per sheep



Uses only 50ml per animal



Dries in around 10 minutes



Fully effective within 15 minutes even in rain, snow, or wind

Thermoskin is natural, biodegradable, and physiologically safe. It does not block the pizzle, anus, vulva, eyes, ears, or mouth.

WHY THERMOSKIN WAS CREATED

In the late 1990s, industrial chemist Henry King began speaking with sheep breeders about the devastating impact of cold snaps on shorn sheep. Many farmers were losing animals despite their best efforts.

After many years of research and development, Thermoskin was launched in 2008. Since then, it has protected many thousands of sheep across Australia and become a trusted, go-to solution for managing sheep welfare and productivity after shearing.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What type of sheep can it be used on?

Thermoskin can be applied to all ages and breeds of sheep, more successfully on sheep scored 2 and higher. It has also been used successfully on mohair and angora goats, and even horses, any animal that needs to be kept warm.

Is the product safe?

Yes. Thermoskin is physiologically harmless, environmentally friendly, 100% biodegradable, and made from all natural ingredients. It will not block the animal's eyes, ears, mouth, pizzle, vulva, or anus.

Can it be used with lice treatment?

Thermoskin can be used with solvent-based lice treatments... but not water-based. If sheep are treated with water-based products, they must be completely dry before applying Thermoskin.

Are there any effects on the wool?

No. Thermoskin is safe for wool and does not damage the fleece. Any residue is easily removed through normal scouring practices.

How do you store the product?

Store the Thermoskin drum at 6°C or above. Below this temperature, the product may separate but will reconstitute once brought back to room temperature

How do you apply the product?

A portable automatic spray unit has been specially designed to atomise Thermoskin as shorn sheep run through. The unit is positioned at the end of the race so that sheep pass through one at a time. The spray unit is available to purchase from your supplier.

How do you clean the equipment?

Clean the spray unit at the end of each day to prevent blocked spray heads. Simply run methylated spirits through the unit using the prime switch for approx. 30 seconds. Then seal the dip tube to protect it from dust.
